Missile Defense Agency Mission


To develop and deploy a **layered** Missile Defense System to **defend** the United States, its deployed forces, allies, and friends from missile attacks in **all phases** of flight



Notional SBX Position




Notional Rendering of HDR-H





Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) Process

- MDA preparing an EIS to evaluate the potential environmental impacts of constructing and operating an HDR-H in accordance with National Environmental Policy Act and Hawaii Environmental Policy Act
 - MDA released Notice of Intent (NOI) in the Federal Register on June 1, 2018 to initiate start of EIS
 - Conducted Public Scoping Meetings in JUN 2018
